- 3. Jurisdiction: Roopanagara, Bogadi post, Mysuru

4. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- **4.1** To foster a spirit of mutual support and goodwill among the Residents of Roopanagara and the members of the Association, thereby promoting communal harmony, co-operation, love and affection.
- **4.2**To look into the welfare of the members and seek remedial measures to their grievances individually or collectively in all matters connected with the layout, houses, amenities, services like street light, water supplies, garbage/weed clearance, drainage maintenance, park maintenance etc.
- **4.3** To create awareness among the residents/members on clean energy, waste management including segregation and composting, water management including rainwater harvesting within individual houses and within Roopanagara, creating urban forest etc with emphasis on protection and conservation of Environment.
- **4.4**To liaison and deal with government and non-government organization like MCC, MUUDA, Gram/Taluk/Zilla panchayath offices, KEB/CESCOM, Water board etc and any other statutory body or Authority on behalf of the residents/members.
- **4.5** To interact and liaison with societies like Deepa House Building Co-operative Society (DHBCS) and institution of similar nature for mutual benefit.
- **4.6** To promote various social, cultural, educational, recreational, sports activities etc like listed below, for the benefit of the members and their department:
 - 4.6.1 Celebrate Nation/State festivals like Independence Day, Republic Day and Kannada Rajyotsava.
 - 4.6.2 Facilitate deserving and meritorious students of Class X and higher from Roopanagara.
 - 4.6.3 Promote welfare programs for residents in general and needy women/children of Roopanagara in particular.
 - 4.6.4 Organize health/eye camps, coordinate with various Government agencies in the event of any natural disaster, pandemic/epidemic etc to ensure safety of the residents.
 - 4.6.5 Establish & maintain libraries, promote sports activities.
 - 4.6.6 Establish and maintain a database of residents to facilitate communication and co-operation amongst the members of the NRRWA from time to time.
- 4.7 To enforce various policies like prohibition of child labor, prohibition of smoking and drinking in public/common areas for the safety and benefit of the residents of Roopanagara.
- 4.8 The Association, in order to meet the monetary requirements, may raise funds in all or any of the following ways:
 - 4.8.1 By contribution/additional contributions,
 - 4.8.2 By deposits and donations from Members/Institutions
 - 4.8.3 By raising maintenance charges and contingency funds for upkeep of the facilities created and
 - 4.8.4 From a common surplus funds which shall form the nucleus of the reserve fund or any other fund.
